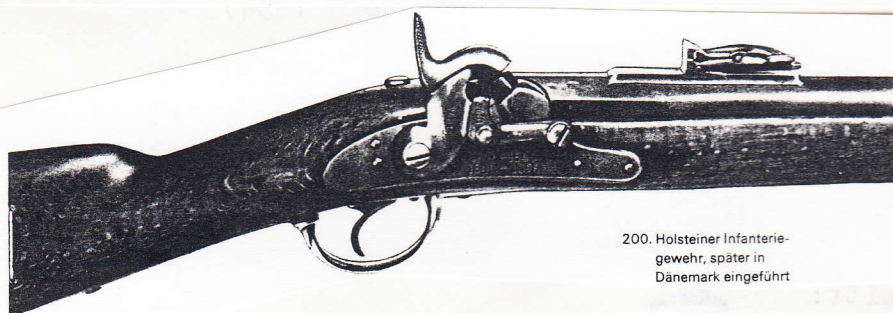
Beutegut aus der Schleswig-Holsteinischen Rebellion, 1851 von der dänischen Armee übernommen und bis 1864 verwendet. Großenteils 1865 von Perkussionszündung zu Snider-Hinterladern umgeändert.

Tapriffel model 1854 (Suhl)



PILLAR-BREECH RIFLE MODEL 1854 (SUHL). Cal. 16.9 mm, 4 grooves. Barrel of cast steel with Dalhoff's curved rear sight. Lock plate marked SUHL beneath a crown. Beech stock, brass mounts. Bayonet has leaf locking spring. This rifle is a shortened version of a pillar-breech rifle converted to the standard Danish calibre. A very large number of rifles of this pattern were taken over by the Danish army from the Slesvig-Holstein rebels in 1851. 12,000 were converted in 1854 and the majority of these were still in use in the war of 1864. In 1865 a number were converted to breech-loading rifles (Snider's system).
